What Mortal Dangers Did Christ Warn His Church to Beware of?

1. Ephesus: the danger of just going through the motions.
2. Smyrna: the danger of starting to fear.

4. Thyatira: the danger of not forsaking personal sins.
5. Sardis: the danger of acting and operating like lost people.
6. Laodicea: the danger of getting distracted from seeing Christ in His Word each day.

Ephesus: The Danger of Coasting. Loss of "first love" is when things get old, and we no longer desire Jesus as much as we remember that we did in the past...

Do we live like we're part of Christ's Special Forces that He has deployed behind enemy lines? Imagine today you are a special forces soldier invited to your final briefing before active duty.

Today you are being sent to patrol, on foot through Afghanistan's Taliban controlled territory.

You know there will be along each step of your patrol: snipers, landmines, remote controlled IED's, as well as RPG's, 50-caliber machine gun nests, thousands of terrorists, and all in the scorching desert heat.

The Commanding Officer giving these LAST WORDS for you before you go, has already made this patrol hundreds of times; and HE is the only one who ever has made it back, unscathed by the enemy. At the briefing HIS personally written field manual for battlefield survival will be explained, plus the key elements of the body armor will be shown, explained, and fitted. Also, the ONLY weapon for offense will be demonstrated and ammunition will be issued.

Wow, wouldn't every one of us being deployed, be there in the front row? We'd all be taking notes, staying after asking questions, helping each other as fellow soldiers getting geared up, and working together for our mutual survival.

Yet today, most of the Special Forces (that's us as believers).... Deployed by the Lord (that's the Great Commission).... Into the harsh and deadly territory of Satan the master terrorist (the god of this world): Are riding around like they are on vacation, Like sitting ducks, riding in the open seats atop a double decker tour bus, Driving through enemy territory.

No daily preparation (pray without ceasing), No body armor (take up the full armor of God), No attendance at the briefings (assembling of yourselves together), No ammunition (but by every Word of God), and No weapons (the sword of the Spirit) in sight.

The daily casualties are horrific as you can imagine, Many wounded soldiers are strewn along the road, Most have flaming darts burning in their unprotected lives, Most are incapacitated and no longer on their mission. Only a few seem to be at the briefings, reading and using the manual, and following the Commanding Officer each day. That is what Jesus found on His visit to His Special Forces bases (the 7 churches in Rev. 1-3).

Are any of us just going through the motions, no longer passionate for Jesus like we used to be?
Are any of us starting to fear how bad the world is getting?
Are any of us getting comfortable around sin, and no longer forsaking personal sins?
Are any of us acting and operating like lost people, and because we're so distracted, we've stopped even seeing Christ in His Word each day?

Ephesus' Spiritual Heart Condition (Revelation 2:1-7)

Ephesus appeared to be thriving. Jesus wasn't first in their schedules, in their concentration, and that signaled: He was no longer the supreme ruler of their hearts and lives. The bottom line: Jesus didn't take first place in their lives. Their heart didn't belong solely to Him. The prognosis was simple: REPENT.

Pergamos' Spiritual Immunity Problems (Revelation 2:12-17): Our Spiritual immunity is compromised when we as believers, as God's own people, are comfortable around what God hates.

Laodicea's Self-Induced Spiritual Blindness: Abandoning Christ as Their Investment Counselor (Rev. 3:17-18)

The Eight Dangers of Too Much Stuff: Investment Advice from the World's Richest Man (Ec. 5:10-15)

Lesson-1: The more stuff we accumulate, the more stuff we will want. "He who loves silver will not be satisfied with silver;" (v. 10a).

Lesson-2: The more stuff we grasp on to, the less satisfied we become. "Nor he who loves abundance, with increase. This also is vanity." (v. 10b).

Lesson-3: The more stuff we own, the more stuff everyone tries to get from us. "When goods increase, They increase who eat them;" (v.11a).

Lesson-4: The more stuff we pile up, the less of it we can really use. "So what profit have the owners except to see them with their eyes?" (v. 11b).

Lesson-5: The more stuff we build up, the more we worry about our stuff. "The sleep of a laboring man is sweet, Whether he eats little or much; But the abundance of the rich will not permit him to sleep." (v. 12).

Lesson-6: The more stuff we hold tightly, the more we get injured from holding onto it. "There is a severe evil which I have seen under the sun: Riches kept for their owner to his hurt." (v. 13).

Lesson-7: The more stuff we keep, the more stuff we can lose. "But those riches perish through misfortune;" (v.14a).

Lesson-8: The more stuff we clutch, the more stuff we must leave behind. "When he begets a son, there is nothing in his hand. As he came from his mother's womb, naked shall he return, To go as he came; And he shall take nothing from his labor Which he may carry away in his hand." (v.15).

Beware of Self-Induced Spiritual Blindness (2 Peter 1:8-9)

Choices that Strengthen Our Focus upon God

1. Make a choice to: Read God's Word before Social Media or any online activities each morning. That choice reflects Christ’s Words in Matthew 6:33 “Seek FIRST the Kingdom of God”.
2. Make a plan to: Create an intentional place of solitude, so that you can not only read God's Word, but also avoid any distractions until you can prayerfully apply the lesson you found: into your own life. That is the MOST VITAL part of each day’s devotional time. Jesus called this in Matthew 4:4 “living by every word of God”.
3. Decide you will start a new habit to: Pray or meditate on a verse instead of listening to music for 15 minutes a day as you walk, drive, or ride. This can transform our travel time into an altar of sacrifice to

God. Many of us are all alone as we travel except that Someone else is there, often sitting right next to us. God is waiting for us to talk to Him, invite Him into our day and JUST BELIEVE that He tags around with us everywhere we go.

4. Take the huge step of fasting from the ultimate distraction of Media: Skip a day of going online, and of Social Media as a fast to prove you are not controlled by anything; and INSTEAD memorize one verse to meditate upon that feeds your soul.
